Q: Are we required to use one of your recommended vendors for alcohol?
A: No. You may purchase the alcohol from any state-regulated vendor and deliver it yourself.

Q: When can the alcohol be delivered? A: Alcohol can be delivered the day before the wedding during our regular business hours. We will provide storage and refrigeration.

Q: What are the drinks served in?
A: Drinks are served in clear plastic cups. Glassware is available at a fee.

Q: What happens to the leftover alcohol? A: Any of your alcohol that has not been used is yours to take home. The bartenders will box it up for you at the end of the reception.

Q: Can the bartenders serve shots? A: No. For the safety and security of all guests, we have a strict "no shots" policy. All drinks with liquor must contain both ice and a mixer.

Q: Will the bartenders have a tip jar?
A: Yes. Unless you request otherwise, in which case you may tip the bartenders yourself. We suggest a gratuity of $\$ 1.00$ per guest per bartender.
